All the applications will then be sent to the committee. The selection committee will consist of five members from the community covering, all age group, experience and gender. The selection committee will make its decision and inform the NCRTA board of its decision. It should be noted that the involvement of the NCRTA is limited to choosing the selection committee and encouraging the community to nominate the outstanding individuals for this award. The selection committee is fully responsible for selecting the winner of the award.

This award is named after NCRTA's first president Saba Ravishankar who passed away in 2011. He was a great role model for the young and old in our community. He was a leader in the community who loved the community, enjoyed community service and sports, and excelled in education.
