Target Hit Pre-School Kids Rules and Information

Date & Time: Saturday, June 23, 2012 -- 8:30 am to 2:00 pm

Venue: Clarke Fields Park (aka CLARK PARK)

93 Houlahan Street, Nepean, Ottawa.

(Strandherd Drive & Gorman Drive in Barrhaven)

Condition: Mini-Field

Entrance fee: \$2 per child (5 attempts per play)

Fee must be paid on or before the start time.

Gender/Age: Kids under 6 years of age

Rules & Information for Target Hitting

Objective To hit the target (Cans) or Wickets from a distance of 20 feet.

Participants Individuals.

Materials Cricket Wickets or Cans and Tennis balls.

- a. If cans are used then empty cans will be stacked together and most cans disturbed will get more points.
- b. If wickets are used then bails need to be knocked down.

Rules

1. Each participant will have 5 attempts per play

Judging

Scoring:

- 1. Total number of hits or cans knocked down will be tallied for total score
- 2. In case of tie. I attempt knockout is played between the highest scorers until a winner is decided.

Final Decision: Judges and Sports coordinators may discuss and modify the rules before the tournament. However, the NCRTA sports coordinator will have the final say on the rules and regulations.
