



## 7th Annual NCRTA Sports Tournament - June 2012

### Adult 7-A-Side soccer tournament -- Male/16-40

### Rules and Information

**Sports Event: Adult 7-A-Side soccer tournament -- Male/16-40 (inclusive)**

**Date: June 24 2012 & Start Time: 10:00 AM**

**Venue:** Clarke Fields Park (AKA Clarke Park),  
93 Houlahan Street, Nepean, ON  
(Strandherd Drive & Gorman Drive in Barrhaven)

**Condition:** Mini outdoor field, 7 a side without offside. Other soccer rules applied

**Entrance fee:** \$10 per person. Fee must be paid on or before the draw date.

**Total Players:** 8

Seven players, and a sub who can be substituted as many times so long as total number of players at a given time shall be 7 in the field. The **maximum** number of players per team is **9**.

**Gender/Age:** Male/16-40 (inclusive).

**Jerseys:** Mandatory, same color t-shirts are ok

**Rules and Regulations:** Tournament Layout: Round Robin depending on the number of teams that are entering (to a maximum of 6 teams). However, each team will play a minimum of 2 two games.

**Game Duration:**

**Group stages: 15-5-15 minute**

**Final: 20-5-20 game.**

**Draw Date:** Friday, June 15th, 2012; All of the captains or assistants must be present at this time and location -- currently planned to be held at the same place (Barrhaven) at 7 PM.

**Awards:** Champions will receive an NCRTA Champion's Cup and the title of NCRTA Champion cup holders until the next year's tournament.

Team name and name of the captain should be sent before June 11<sup>th</sup>, 2012. The names (both first and last name) of the rest of the players and their age, jersey colours must be submitted before Friday June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2011 via email to or phone.

The captain of each team must email back to confirm their participation.

**Final Decision:** Team captains and sports coordinators may discuss and modify the rules before the tournament. However, the NCRTA sports coordinator will have the final say on the rules and regulations.
